

2010 ucpn Texas Hold'em Poker

TOURNAMENT RULES

\$300 per person prior to event date, \$325 per person at the door (100% tax-deductible) includes food, drinks from 4pm to 5pm and two drink tickets for the remainder of the evening. Players will receive 2,000 chips. We will register a maximum of 300 players.

Guests wishing to attend the event, but not participate in the poker tournament may purchase Spectator Tickets at \$25 per person to include food, drinks from 4pm to 5pm and two drink tickets for the remainder of the evening.

Re-buys will be available for the first hour for players with 2,000 chips or less - \$300 for 2,000 chips or \$150 for 1,000 chips.

One add-on will be offered to all players at the end of the first hour - \$300 for 2,000 chips.

The first two rounds will be 30 minutes each, and the remaining rounds will be 20 minutes each. There will be breaks at the end of each hour.

The blinds will start at 25/50 for the first round, go to 50/100 for the second round, then 100/200 and so on. We reserve the right to increase the rate of the blinds as needed.

Prizes will be awarded to the top ten finishers. The Grand Prize is entry into the 2010 World Series of Poker Main Event in July in Las Vegas, plus airfare and a week's stay. The \$10,000 No-Limit Texas Hold 'em Main Event will take place beginning July 5, until the final table is reached on July 17, 2010.

From the East: Take the Southern State Parkway to Exit 23 (Meadowbrook Road). At the end of the exit ramp, make a right onto Meadowbrook Road. Go to the first traffic light (Washington Avenue) and make a right. As you come down from the overpass you will see the Center on your left.

From the West: Take Northern State Parkway to Meadowbrook Parkway to the Southern State Parkway (Eastbound). Do not merge into traffic, but stay in the right lane which ends at Exit 23 (Meadowbrook Road). At the end of the exit ramp, make a left turn onto Meadowbrook Road. Go to the first traffic light (Washington Avenue) and make a right. As you come down from the overpass you will see the Center on your left.
